Video Description

The Winslow Homer: Round Table Wrap-Up summarized a day of talks by noted scholars, curators and college and university professors. A group discussion was moderated by Ann Rogers-Haley and supported by Kathleen Foster of the Philadelphia Museum of Art, Sylvia Yount of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, and Martha Tedeschi of the Harvard Art Museum. This discussion reflects how the Cape Ann Museum's exhibition revealed new aspects of Homer, for the first time placing these paintings, drawings and even ceramic work in their rich geographic,
