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#### **Video Description**

This live gallery performance with instrumentals, vocals, and dance was offered in conjunction with the multi-media mother/daughter exhibition *Rachel Perry Welty and Sarah Hollis Perry: water, water* that was on view at the Cape Ann Museum

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from July 14 through September 30, 2012, and featured a video installation, “Drawing a Line with the Tide,” that was filmed in Annisquam. In tandem with the theme of water, local musicians Brian King and Kristen Miller and dancer Sarah Slifer perform an evocative contemporary three-part piece that begins in front of the video installation, moves to the atrium, and finishes in the third floor special exhibitions gallery.
